Call for submissions to the Best Student Paper Award for the *International Symposium on Global Change Research*, 2013

All submitted papers and their presentations will be evaluated by a review committee appointed by the conference organizing committee in terms of scientific significance, creativity, application values, and quality of writing and presentation. The results of this competition will be announced at the closing ceremony of the *Symposium* in Nanjing. The winners of this competition will be reimbursed for the registration fees for the *Symposium*, travel and lodging costs, plus cash awards.
